## Government Documents

The UW-Madison Steenbock Memorial Library has a collection of federal government documents including publications from the USDA and other federal agencies that deal with agriculture. The collection also includes publications issued by the University of Wisconsin-Madison Experiment Station and Cooperative Extension Service, as well as publications issued by other states' agricultural experiment stations and extension services.

## Agriculture Network Information Center

Agriculture-related websites, full-text documents, citations, images and other resources. "AgNIC partners are comprised of professional librarians, extension experts, and information specialists with advanced degrees in specific subjects." Relevant topics include animal welfare, animal law, and veterinary law. Search limit strategies available.
