

1192 DUTY OF DRIVER APPROACHING INTERSECTION WHEN AMBER LIGHT SHOWS

A safety statute provides that a driver facing a yellow signal shown with or following a green light, shall stop before entering the intersection unless so close to it that a stop cannot be made in safety.

If you find that the yellow or amber light, which signifies caution, was showing before (____) entered the intersection, then (____) was required to stop unless (he) (she) was so close to the traffic signal that a stop could not be made in safety.
