In the upcoming months, the following e-newsletters will be available to subscribers. If you are interested in receiving any of the following, please contact DCLRC. All newsletters will be available only via email.

1. **Legal Research Tips**: Tips include how to access legal resources using electronic databases and the Internet, as well as tips on finding and using specific resources. This e-newsletter will be sent out once a month to subscribers.
2. **Internet Tips**: Tips for accessing the Internet using Microsoft Internet Explorer, including definitions of common terms and functions, as well as shortcuts and basic functions such as searching, printing, and security. Designed for the person who is new to computers or unfamiliar with using the Internet, this e-newsletter will be sent out once a month to subscribers.
3. **Legal Research Reports**: Substantial reports of a particular legal topic that include web links and bibliography. Reports may be an interview with a local legal authority, research on a legal topic of current local or national interest, or a more in-depth examination of an historical figure or legal topic, such as the history of the Dane County Courthouse. This e-newsletter will be sent out quarterly, with four articles per year.
